Dear Chair Griffin

I am writing to withdraw SB378. This bill would have allowed minors over 14 to be vaccinated. Doctors would have determined whether a minor was able to comprehend the treatment. Seventeen states including Arkansas, Idaho, Louisiana, and North Carolina have already enacted laws to allow some minors to be vaccinated without parental consent. These precedents clearly demonstrate the wisdom and benefit of expanding access to potentially life-saving vaccines.

Unfortunately, I started working on this issue fairly late in the legislative session. We just haven't had the time or staff to fine-tune some aspects of the bill. In the interest of promoting the health and safety of young Marylanders, I will research the issue over the interim.

Please remove SB378 from your hearing schedule on February 22nd.
